## **POURING PAINT MINI-WORKSHOP**

If you've ever wanted to try watercolor pouring, this six-hour mini-workshop is for you. Signature artist Nancy Mysak will show you how to pour transparent watercolors step by step. She will demonstrate the process to help you begin your own pouring with hands-on guidance. The session will be from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. on May 22<sup>nd</sup> and 10 a.m. to Noon on May 23<sup>rd</sup>. The cost for attending is \$30, paid at the door.

### **Supplies and Materials:**

- Quarter sheets of Arches 140 lb. cold-pressed watercolor paper
- Paints for pouring: 15 ml or 37 ml of *Da Vinci* Hansa Yellow Light, *Da Vinci* Rose Red Deep, and *Da Vinci* Phthalo Blue OR *American Journey* Joe's Yellow, Joe's Red, and Joe's Blue
- Masking tape – 2" wide
- Palette with your usual colors & water container
- Masking fluid (make sure it is white and very runny), such as Windsor Newton. Round all synthetic brushes (round #2 & #8) with good point for applying frisket.
- Other brushes: (1) three small, flat brushes for mixing paint in cups...(Cheap Joe's Ugly brush #8 flat); (2) a 2" flat brush for applying CLEAN water to paper before pouring, which has never been used for pigment; and (3) several of your watercolor brushes to finish your painting
- Six small clear plastic cups (6-8 oz.) for mixing paints and holding frisket, water, and soap (white liquid or white bar)
- Spray bottle with adjustable nozzle; water container for when you paint with a brush
- Paper towels, towel, and aluminum "turkey pan" to catch running paint
- Exacto knife
- Rubber cement pick-up
- Apron and/or wear old clothes

**Note:** Participants will receive a complete handout with instructions on two assignments they have to complete and bring to the session.

**Please bring your lunch. DWS will supply beverages and some snacks.**
